Summary of The Heelwork Test Content

The content is the maximum allowed at each level, as the classes progress the list shows what manoeuvres may be added.

This is only an aide-memoire and should be read in conjunction with the G Regulations.

The basis of a Heelwork test is a combination of straight lines and turns (Introductory Class excepted).

Judges may include circles and/or arcs as detailed in the table below

Class	Turns & Manoeuvres	Circles & Arcs	Paces
Introductory	No turns, a Straight Line or a Large Circle		Normal
Pre-Beginner	Right, Left & About	Large Circles or Arcs	
Beginners			
Novice	Diagonal turns to the right		
Class A	Diagonal turns to the left		
Class B	Left about turn at normal and slow pace. Only right, diagonal right, left, and about turns at fast pace.	Medium Circles or Arcs	Fast and Slow Changes of pace from the Halt
Class C	Multiple turns at normal and slow pace, about turn right turn, left about turn left turn, double about turn, double left about turn. ASSD at Normal pace	Small Circles or Arcs Figure of eight and weaves at normal and slow only	Changes of pace may be from the halt or on the move.
